2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

4 **Sec. 1. 12 MRSA §7794, sub-§4-A** is enacted to read:

6 4-A. Exempt. All watercraft requiring or requesting
8 certificates of number and equipped with electric outboard motors
10 are exempt from paying fees for the certificates of number.
