	locations in the State licensed to sell spirits for consumption

	another in accordance with this section must notify the bureau of

4.4	This amendment clarifies that if a business or corporation
44	licensed to sell spirits for off-premises consumption has multiple licensed locations in the State the licensee may
46	transfer spirits only between those licensed locations and
-	requires that a licensee notify the Department of Public Safety,
48	Bureau of Liquor Enforcement in advance of the transfer of
	spirits between one location and another.

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
