2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

4 **Sec. 1. 28-A MRSA §1201-A** is enacted to read:

6 **§1201-A. Transfer of spirits among certain licensees**

8 Notwithstanding section 606, subsection 1 and section 1201,
10 subsection 3-A, if a business or corporation has multiple
12 locations licensed to sell spirits for consumption off the
14 premises, spirits may be transferred from one of those licensed
16 locations to another to facilitate the sale of those spirits.

18 **SUMMARY**

20 This bill provides that a business or corporation with
22 multiple locations licensed to sell spirits for consumption off
24 the premises may transfer spirits between one licensed location
26 and another.
