**Sec. 1. Examination of cost savings resulting from early retirement.**

2 **Resolved:** That the Commissioner of Administrative and Financial  
4 Services, with the participation and assistance of the Maine  
6 State Retirement System, shall conduct a thorough examination of  
8 the potential cost savings that might result from offering state  
10 employees the option of an early retirement. The commissioner  
12 shall compile the results of the review and shall present the  
14 findings, along with any necessary implementing language, to the  
16 Joint Standing Committee on Appropriations and Financial Affairs  
18 no later than November 15, 2003. Following receipt and review of  
20 the report, the joint standing committee may report out  
legislation related to the report to the Second Regular Session  
of the 121st Legislature.

**SUMMARY**

18 This resolve directs the Commissioner of Administrative and  
20 Financial Services, with the assistance of the Maine State  
Retirement System, to examine the potential cost savings of  
offering state employees early retirement.
