2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

4 **Sec. 1. 23 MRSA §1807, sub-§6,** as enacted by PL 2001, c. 681,
§1, is amended to read:

6 **6. Rules.** The commissioner shall adopt rules to implement
this section. The rules must give preference to towns that
8 operate a transit service that has a regional component. Rules
adopted pursuant to this subsection are routine technical rules
10 as defined in Title 5, chapter 375, subchapter ~~II~~-A 2-A.

12 **SUMMARY**

14 This bill directs the Department of Transportation to adopt
16 rules regarding the transit bonus payment program that give
preference to towns that operate a transit service that has a
18 regional component.
