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COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 358, L.D. 466, Bill, "An
Act Concerning the Issuance of a Temporary Liquor License"

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Amend the bill by striking out all of section 2 and
inserting in its place the following:

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'Sec. 2. 28-A MRSa §1051, sub-§2-A is enacted to read:

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2-A. Temporary license upon transfer of ownership. An
applicant applying for a new license, in accordance with
subsection 2, resulting from the transfer of ownership of an
existing on-premises license may simultaneously apply to the
bureau for a temporary on-premises license. The bureau may issue
a temporary license upon application unless the municipal
officers or county commissioners notify the bureau of their
objection to the issuance of the license. A temporary license
issued in accordance with this subsection is valid from the date
it is issued until a decision is made on the application for an
annual on-premises license or for 60 days, whichever is shorter.
The fee for a temporary license issued under this subsection is
\$100.'

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SUMMARY

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This amendment replaces the section in the bill regarding
the issuance of a temporary on-premises liquor license pending
the issuance or denial of an annual license for an establishment

2 that has had a transfer in ownership. With this amendment, a
temporary license is applied for at the same time an annual
license application is submitted. The Department of Public
4 Safety, Bureau of Liquor Enforcement may issue a temporary
license for up to 60 days, unless there is objection from the
6 municipal officials or county commissioners. The fee for a
temporary license is \$100.
