SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 361, L.D. 469, Bill, "An Act To Clarify Arrest Powers of Law Enforcement Officers"

Amend the amendment by striking out all of section 5.

SUMMARY

This amendment eliminates that provision of Committee Amendment "A" that authorizes the trustees of the University of Maine System to empower the university system's full-time police officers to make arrests described in the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 17-A, section 15 outside university property, subject to the same training requirements, liability protection and notification requirements governing counties and municipalities for this purpose.
