
Amend the amendment by striking out all of section 5 and inserting in its place the following:

'Sec. 5. Report. Resolved: That the committee shall incorporate its findings and recommendations, including suggested legislation, into the annual report required under the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 30-A, section 4350, subsection 9, paragraph A and provide a copy of the report to the Joint Standing Committee on Business, Research and Economic Development no later than December 1, 2003; and be it further'

SUMMARY

This amendment clarifies the reporting requirements by mandating that the Community Preservation Advisory Committee's findings and recommendations, including any suggested legislation, must be included in the annual report already required by statute. The amendment also changes the reporting date to December 1, 2003.
