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## SUMMARY

16 This bill raises ATV registration fees to \$50 and dedicates the increase to ATV enforcement and safety education. The bill requires the Department of Inland Fisheries and Wildlife to ensure that registration plates are displayed in a manner that 20 will allow for easy identification of registration numbers and repeals the ATV registration reciprocity law. The bill also 22 requires ATV operators to get prior written permission to operate an ATV on the land of another and provides treble damages to a 24 land or property owner whose property is damaged by use of an ATV.
