	This amendment removes from the committee amendment language
26	that directs that a Justice of the Superior Court, upon being notified by the sheriff of a county in which an inmate has been
28	determined by a competent medical authority to require inpatient treatment for mental illness, may issue an order transferring the
30	inmate to a forensic hospital for treatment. This amendment also strikes language that directs that an inmate with respect to whom
32	an application and a certification under the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 34-B, section 3863 are made must be admitted to
34	either state mental health forensic institute.
