	<u>§146. Maine Week of Heroes</u>

	Each political subdivision and school administrative unit is
8	encouraged to observe a Maine Week of Heroes during the week,
	commencing on a Sunday and ending on the next following Saturday,
10	within which September 11th occurs. The observance may include
	public proclamations, appropriate ceremonies and the introduction
12	of curricula in school systems recognizing the efforts of heroic
	people in Maine communities, such as active duty military
14	personnel, emergency medical technicians, firefighters, law
	enforcement officers, members of the National Guard, members of
16	the United States Coast Guard, United States military veterans
	and all other heroes who have given their courageous service
18	without regard for their own lives or personal safety to benefit
	the people of this great land and to serve the needs of the
20	citizens of the State.
