commissioner and the Commissioner of Corrections to be
8 unnecessary to the present or future operation of the Long Creek
Youth Development Center; and be it further

10 **Sec. 2. Deed restrictions. Resolved:** That the Commissioner of
Administrative and Financial Services shall establish deed
12 restrictions for the purpose of preserving historic landmarks on
the site.
