2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

4 **Sec. 1. 33 MRSA c. 43** is enacted to read:

6 **CHAPTER 43**

8 **COMPENSATION FOR PROPERTY OWNERS**

10 **§2001. State reimbursement to property owner for reduction in value of property**

12 The State shall reimburse a property owner for the reduction
14 in value of property caused by a prohibition on rebuilding a
16 structure damaged by fire, storm or other natural catastrophe.
18 As used in this section, the term "property" means all property,
20 including, but not limited to, waterfront property on the ocean
or a lake, pond or river. Compensation paid to a property owner
must be based on the difference between the assessed value before
the catastrophe and an appraised value after the catastrophe.

22 **SUMMARY**

24 This bill requires the State to reimburse a property owner
26 for the reduction in value of property caused by a prohibition on
rebuilding a structure damaged by fire, storm or other natural
28 catastrophe. Compensation paid to a property owner must be based
on the difference between the assessed value before the
catastrophe and an appraised value after the catastrophe.
