- 18 This bill creates the State Board of Corporate Ethics to make grants to promote better corporate ethics. The board makes 20 grants from a fund created by fines and penalties collected by the State for violations of the Maine Unfair Trade Practices Act, 22 the Revised Maine Securities Act or laws providing penalties for
  - fraudulent conduct.
