An Act To Require That Mental Health Workers with LCPC Licenses Are Recognized as Licensed Professionals for Purposes of Insurance Reimbursement

#### Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

Sec. 1. 24-A MRSA §2744, as amended by PL 1995, c. 561, §2, 4 is further amended to read:

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## §2744. Mental health services

8 Notwithstanding any provision of a health insurance 1. policy subject to this chapter, whenever the policy provides for 10 payment or reimbursement for services which that are within the lawful scope of practice of a psychologist licensed to practice 12 in this Stater: a certified social worker licensed for the independent practice of social work in this State who has at least a masters degree in social work from an accredited 14 educational institution, has been employed in social work for at 16 least 2 years, and who, after January 1, 1985, must be licensed as a clinical social worker in this Stater; a licensed clinical 18 professional counselor licensed for the independent practice of counseling who has at least a masters degree in counseling from 20 an accredited educational institution, has been employed in counseling for at least 2 years and, after January 1, 2002, must 22 be licensed as a clinical professional counselor in this State, or a licensed nurse who is certified by the American Nurses' 24 Association as a clinical specialist in adult psychiatric and mental health nursing or as a clinical specialist in child and 26 adolescent psychiatric and mental health nursing, any person covered by the policy shall-be is entitled to reimbursement for 28 these services if the services are performed by a physician  $r_i$  a psychologist licensed to practice in this Stater; a certified social worker licensed for the independent practice of social 30 work who has at least a masters degree in social work from an 32 accredited educational institution, who has been employed in social work for at least 2 years, and who, after January 1, 1985, 34 must be licensed as a clinical social worker in this State,; a licensed clinical professional counselor licensed for the independent practice of counseling who has at least a masters 36 degree in counseling from an accredited educational institution, 38 has been employed in counseling for at least 2 years and, after January 1, 2002, must be licensed as a clinical professional 40 counselor in this State; or a licensed nurse certified by the American Nurses' Association as a clinical specialist in adult or child and adolescent psychiatric and mental health nursing. With 42 respect-to-services-provided by physicians or psychologists, -this 44 section -- applies-to-all-health-insurance-policies,-contracts-or gertifigates--issued, -- renewed, -- modified, -- altered, -- amended -- or reissued-on-or-after-July-1,-1975. Payment or reimbursement for 46 services rendered by clinical social workers licensed in this 48 State shall, licensed clinical professional counselors licensed in this State or licensed nurses certified by the American Nurses' Association as clinical specialists in adult or child and 50

adolescent psychiatric and mental health nursing may not be conditioned upon prior diagnosis or referral by a physician or other health care professional, except in cases where diagnosis of the condition for which the services are rendered is beyond the scope of their licensure.

Sec. 3. 24-A MRSA §4234-A, sub-§8, as enacted by PL 1995, c. 18 407, §10, is amended to read:

20 8. Contracts; providers. Subject to approval by the superintendent pursuant to section 4204, a health maintenance 22 organization incorporated under this chapter shall allow providers, pursuant to sections 2744 and 2835, to contract for 24 and receive payment, subject to the health maintenance organization's credentialling policy, for the provision of mental 26 health services within the scope of the provider's licensure.

Sec. 4. Application. This Act applies to all policies, contracts and certificates executed, delivered, issued for delivery, continued or renewed in this State on or after January 1, 2004. For purposes of this Act, all contracts are deemed to be renewed no later than the next yearly anniversary of the contract date.

### SUMMARY

38 This bill mandates that all health care plans reimburse licensed clinical professional counselors for mental health 40 services. The bill applies to all policies and contracts issued or renewed on or after January 1, 2004.

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
