### Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

#### Sec. 1. 35-A MRSA §703, sub-§3-B is enacted to read:

	3-B. Exemptions for certain telephone utilities. The
6	commission may adopt by rule standards and procedures for
	granting exemptions to telephone utilities or specified groups of
8	telephone utilities from the approval requirement of subsection
	3-A. Such an exemption must be accompanied by a finding that the
10	exemption is in the public interest and will not have a negative
	impact on competitive markets for telephone services. The
12	commission may limit an exemption to a specific geographic area.
	<u>A telephone utility granted an exemption pursuant to a rule</u>
14	adopted under this subsection remains subject to other applicable
	provisions of this Title and commission rules. For good cause,
16	as defined by the commission by rule, the commission may revoke
	any exemption granted pursuant to this subsection. A revocation
18	may be in whole or in part and may be specific to a single
	telephone utility or a single telephone utility service. Rules
20	adopted pursuant to this subsection are routine technical rules
	<u>as defined in Title 5, chapter 375, subchapter 2-A.</u>

26 This bill authorizes the Public Utilities Commission to adopt rules to grant exemptions from the requirement that telephone utilities obtain commission approval for special rate 28 contracts with their customers.
