2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

4 **Sec. 1. 29-A MRSA §2458, sub-§2, ¶O**, as amended by PL 1997, c.  
776, §48, is further amended to read:

6 O. Has a license, permit or the privilege to apply for or  
8 obtain a license suspended or revoked by a jurisdiction of  
the United States or a province; or

10 **Sec. 2. 29-A MRSA §2458, sub-§2, ¶P**, as enacted by PL 1997, c.  
12 776, §49, is amended to read:

14 P. Has failed to provide a valid social security number  
pursuant to section 1301-~~;~~ or

16 **Sec. 3. 29-A MRSA §2458, sub-§2, ¶Q** is enacted to read:

18 O. Has operated a motor vehicle at an imprudent speed or at  
20 a rate of speed that exceeded the maximum speed limit by 30  
miles per hour or more and caused an accident that resulted  
22 in the death of another person.

24 **SUMMARY**

26 This bill gives the Secretary of State the authority to  
28 administratively suspend the license of a motor vehicle operator  
30 who operated a motor vehicle at an imprudent speed or at a rate  
of speed that exceeded the maximum speed limit by 30 miles per  
hour or more and caused an accident that resulted in the death of  
another person.
