SUMMARY

This amendment is the majority report of the Joint Standing Committee on Labor. It deletes the provision of the bill allowing the Workers' Compensation Board to impose a \$500 surcharge on an employer following mediation under certain circumstances. The bill would continue to provide for a \$1,500 surcharge following formal hearing when the employee retains or obtains a greater benefit than the employer offered prior to the hearing.
