22	Amend the bill by striking out everything after the enacting
24	clause and before the summary and inserting in its place the following:
26	'Sec. 1. 8 MRSA §374, sub-§5, as amended by PL 2003, c. 414,
28	Pt. B, $\S17$ and affected by Pt. D, $\S7$, is further amended to read:
30	5. Wildlife lottery game. No later than January 30, 1996, the commission, in consultation with the Maine Outdoor Heritage
32	Fund Board, shall develop and initiate a wildlife lottery game designed to raise funds for the Maine Outdoor Heritage Fund
34	established pursuant to Title 12, chapter 903, subchapter 6. The sales commission paid to agents for the sale of wildlife lottery
36	game tickets must be one percentage point higher than the sales commission paid to agents for the sale of other instant lottery
38	<u>game tickets.</u> The commission shall provide the net proceeds of this wildlife lottery game to the Maine Outdoor Heritage Fund
40	annually. The commission shall change the wildlife game ticket periodically throughout the year.'

46	This amendment replaces the bill and is the majority
48	report. The amendment increases the sales commission paid to agents for the sale of wildlife lottery tickets so that it is one
50	percentage point higher than the sales commission paid to agents for the sale of other instant tickets.

Based on the total commissions paid to agents for the sale of wildlife lottery tickets in recent years, the increase in commission fees will result in an estimated net loss of annual revenues to the Maine Outdoor Heritage Fund ranging from \$30,000 to \$60,000 beginning in fiscal year 2004-05.
