42	This amendment removes the requirement that the Commissioner

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committee of the Legislature having jurisdiction over transportation matters prior to dismantling state-owned track. The commissioner would still be required to review the proposed dismantling with the committee.

It also amends language regarding the review of tax provisions applying to railroads. It removes the requirement that the chairs of the Joint Standing Committee on Taxation appoint a subcommittee. It specifies that the review and development of recommendations regarding tax laws must take place during interim meetings authorized by the presiding officers of the Legislature.
