An Act To Increase the Debt Limit of the Rockland Port District

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows: 2 Sec. 1. P&SL 1951, c. 108, §4, first sentence, as amended by P&SL 1957, c. 78, \S 2, is further amended to read: 4 6 To procure funds for the purposes of this act, and for such other expenses as may be necessary to carry out said purposes, the said district, by its trustees, is hereby authorized from time to time 8 to borrow money and to issue its bonds or notes therefor, but shall not incur a total indebtedness at any one time outstanding 10 exceeding the sum of \$100,000 \$600,000. 12 **SUMMARY** 14 16 This bill raises the debt limit of the Rockland Port District from its 1951 limit of \$100,000 to \$600,000 based on 18 calculations converting the value in today's worth.
