HOUSE AMENDMENT "B" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 472, L.D. 642, Bill, "An Act To Ensure the Economic Viability of the Harness Racing Industry"

Amend the amendment in section 1 in subsection 5-A by striking out all of paragraph A.

Further amendment the amendment in section 1 in subsection 5-A in paragraph B in the first line (page 1, line 45 in amendment) by striking out the following: "B." and inserting in its place the following: 'A.'

SUMMARY

Under Committee Amendment "A," a high-stakes beano license may be issued to any federally recognized Maine tribe if on January 1, 2004 the tribe was eligible to conduct but was not operating high-stakes beano. This restriction would prevent the Penobscot Nation from operating high-stakes beano on nontribal land. This amendment removes that restriction.
