2	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
2	Sec. 1. 12 MRSA §7035, sub-§1, ¶B, as amended by PL 1993, c. 265, §1, is further amended to read:
6	B. A municipality or political subdivision of the State may
8	not enact any ordinance, law or rule regulating the hunting, trapping or fishing for any species of fish or wildlife; the
10	operation, registration or numbering of watercraft or snowmobiles; or any other subject matter of chapter 715,
12	subchapters I 1 and II 2. For purposes of this paragraph, except as provided in subparagraphs (3) and (4), the
14	regulation of fishing includes the regulation of ice fishing shacks. Nothing in this paragraph may be construed to prohibit the following:
