HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 486, L.D. 656, Bill, "An Act to Allow Beverage Sales from Mobile Service Bars on Golf Courses"

Amend the amendment in paragraph J in the last line (page 1, line 34 in amendment) by striking out the following: "and"


Further amend the amendment in paragraph K in the last line (page 1, line 40 in amendment) by striking out the following: "section." and inserting in its place the following: 'section; and'

Further amend the amendment by inserting after paragraph K the following:

'L. Malt liquor is sold, served or dispensed from a mobile service bar only during a golf tournament in which all the players are 21 years of age or older.'

**SUMMARY**

This amendment provides that malt liquor may be sold, served or dispensed from a mobile service bar only during a golf tournament in which all the players are 21 years of age or older.
