HOUSE AMENDMENT "B" to S.P. 237, L.D. 673, Bill, "An Act To Increase Maine's Minimum Wage"


Amend the bill by inserting after section 1 the following:

'Sec. 2. 26 MRSA §664, as amended by PL 2003, c. 423, §§1 and 2 and affected by §5, is further amended by adding at the end a new paragraph to read:

Employees who are under the age of 19 and are regularly enrolled in an educational institution or are on vacation therefrom may be paid a rate of not less than the federal minimum wage of the applicable minimum wage rate required for other employees in the same occupation.'

SUMMARY

This amendment requires that employees under 19 years of age must be paid at a rate no lower than the federal minimum wage.
