SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 237, L.D. 673, Bill, "An Act To Increase Maine's Minimum Wage"

Amend the bill in section 1 in subsection 1 in the 5th line (page 1, line 10 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "\$6.65" and inserting in its place the following: '\$6.35' and in the 6th line (page 1, line 11 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "\$7" and inserting in its place the following: '\$6.50'

SUMMARY

This amendment increases the minimum wage from the current \$6.25 per hour to \$6.50 per hour in 2 phases, in the first phase an increase of 10¢ per hour and in the 2nd phase an increase of 15¢ per hour rather than increases to \$6.65 per hour and \$7 per hour as in the bill.
