## SUMMARY

This amendment is the majority report of the Joint Standing Committee on Business, Research and Economic Development and replaces the bill. The amendment changes the membership of the Plumbers' Examining Board by substituting a local plumbing inspector who has been engaged in plumbing inspections for at least 4 years and is employed by a municipality for one of the journeyman plumbers currently on the board. The amendment takes effect on September 24, 2004, which is the expiration date of the term of the current board member who is a local plumbing inspector.
