An Act To Expand the Membership of the Plumbers' Examining Board To Include a Local Plumbing Inspector

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

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Sec. 1. 32 MRSA §3401, first ¶, as amended by PL 1989, c. 503, Pt. B, §140, is further amended to read:

-A- The Plumbers' Examining Board, as established by Title 5, section 12004-A, subsection 32, ~~shall consist~~ consists of 5 6 members, ~~who shall be~~ appointed by the Governor. One of the members ~~shall~~ must be a representative of the public, 2 ~~shall~~ must be master plumbers as defined in section 3301, and 2 ~~shall~~ must be journeyman plumbers as defined in section 3301, both of whom have been engaged in the business of plumbing for at least 2 years, and one must be a local plumbing inspector.

SUMMARY

This bill expands the membership of the Plumbers' Examining Board to include one member who is a local plumbing inspector.
