amendment, which is the majority report of the This committee, restricts the ability of a person, corporation or 40 other entity to deny goods or services to a consumer on the basis 42 of that consumer's failure to provide a social security number, except when otherwise permitted or required by state or federal law or when the purpose of the request for the social security 44 number is to permit the requesting party to obtain a credit report for a "permissible purpose" under the state Fair Credit 46 Reporting Act or the United States Fair Credit Reporting Act. The amendment exempts banks and credit unions and their agents, 48 subsidiaries and affiliates; licensed supervised lenders; companies engaged in the business of insurance; health care and 50 pharmaceutical companies; companies that conduct necessary 52 background checks; and companies that must
