2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

4 **Sec. 1. 17 MRSA §3203**, as repealed and replaced by PL 1995,
c. 625, Pt. B, §3, is amended by adding at the end a new
6 paragraph to read:

8 A person otherwise subject to this section who operates a
9 motor vehicle dealership within 10 miles of the New Hampshire
10 border may operate that business on Sunday between the hours of
11 12:00 p.m. and 4:00 p.m.

12 **SUMMARY**

14 This bill allows a motor vehicle dealership to be operated
16 on Sunday between the hours of 12:00 p.m. and 4:00 p.m. if that
business is located within 10 miles of the New Hampshire border.
