6	I. Any licensed foster parent caring for a child or children in the foster parent's residence whose care is
8	reimbursed through the Department of Human Services for the period during which the child or children are in that foster

12	Sec. 2. 5 MRSA $\S285$ , sub- $\S1$ , $\PJ$ , as enacted by PL 2001, c. 667, Pt. E, $\S3$ , is amended to read:
14	J. Legislative employees that are recipients of retirement
16	allowances from the Maine State Retirement System based upon creditable service as teachers, as defined by section 17001,

20	Sec. 3. 5 MRSA §285, sub-§1, ¶¶K and L are enacted to read:
22	K. Any employee of a federally qualified health center; and
24	L. Any employee of the Maine Primary Care Association, or its successor association of community health centers.
