2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

4 **Sec. 1. 25 MRSA §2929, sub-§2, ¶¶C and D,** as enacted by PL
1997, c. 291, §3, are amended to read:

6 C. A public safety answering point may disclose
7 confidential information to designees of the bureau director
8 for the purpose of system maintenance and quality control;
9 and

10 D. The bureau director may disclose confidential information
11 to public safety answering points, public or private safety
12 agencies, emergency responders or others within the E-9-1-1
13 system to the extent necessary to implement and manage the
14 E-9-1-1 system; and

16 **Sec. 2. 25 MRSA §2929, sub-§2, ¶E** is enacted to read:

18 E. The bureau director may disclose or permit the
19 disclosure of confidential information to a public safety
20 agency to the extent necessary to allow that public safety
21 agency to place outgoing emergency calls.

24 **SUMMARY**

26 This bill amends the confidentiality provisions of the
27 E-9-1-1 law to permit the use or disclosure of E-9-1-1 system
28 information to public safety agencies to the extent necessary to
29 allow the use of the system to make outgoing emergency calls.
