Sec. 1. 30-A MRSA §4329 is enacted to read:
§4329. Municipal surcharge authorized
The legislative body of a municipality may impose a
surcharge on new construction located outside its designated
growth area, identified pursuant to section 4326.
A municipality that elects to adopt a surcharge pursuant to
this section shall apply the surcharge in the manner and in the
amount authorized by that municipality's legislative body.
SUMMARY
This bill authorizes a municipality to impose a surcharge on new construction located outside its designated growth area.
