2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

4 **Sec. 1. 21-A MRSA, c. 9, sub-c. 2, Art. 4,** is amended by repealing
the article headnote and enacting in its place the following:

6 **Article 4**
8 **CAMPAIGNING**

10 **Sec. 2. 21-A MRSA §683** is enacted to read:

12 **§683. State postsecondary educational institutions**

14 A candidate for public office may campaign in a dormitory of
the University of Maine System, the Maine Technical College
System or the Maine Maritime Academy.
