	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
2	Sec. 1. 36 MRSA §5219-W is enacted to read:
Ŧ	<u>§5219-W. Private school tuition</u>

	<u>A taxpayer is allowed a credit against the tax otherwise due</u>
8	under this Part of up to \$1,000 for tuition for the taxpayer or
	the taxpayer's dependent paid by the taxpayer to a private school
10	for the same taxable year. The credit may not reduce the state
	income tax to less than zero.

16	This bill allows an income tax credit of up to \$1,000 for tuition paid to a private school for a taxpayer or a dependent of
