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This amendment replaces the bill with a resolve that directs the Department of Human Services, Bureau of Health to adopt rules requiring the development of protocols regarding the use of latex gloves. It directs the Bureau of Health to report back to the Joint Standing Committee on Health and Human Services regarding the rules, the development of protocols, the anticipated impact of the protocols and whether legislation is required to further address allergies to latex gloves by January 30, 2004. It designates the rules as routine technical rules.
