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COMMITTEE AMENDMENT

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COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 263, L.D. 768

2 Further amend the bill by striking out all of section 2 and inserting in its place the following: 4 'Sec. 2. 5 MRSA §22002, sub-§8, as enacted by PL 2001, c. 439, 6 Pt. T, §5, is amended to read: 8 8. Use of trust fund. The authority may use up to 15% \$407,000 of the trust fund for administrative expenses in each 10 fiscal year, except that the total amount of the trust fund that may be used for administrative expenses for the duration of the 12 program may not exceed \$1,500,000.' 14 Further amend the bill by inserting at the end before the summary the following: 16 'Emergency clause. In view of the emergency cited in the preamble, this Act takes effect when approved.' 18 20 SUMMARY 22 This amendment revises the cap on administrative expenses 24 for the Baxter Compensation Authority. Current law limits the administrative expenses to 15% of the trust fund each year; the bill deletes the cap altogether. This amendment limits the 26 expenses to \$407,000 per fiscal year, which is the total of the first-year costs estimated by the authority in its report of 28 January 15, 2003, except that the authority is limited by an 30 overall cap on administrative expenses. Over the course of the operation of the program, the maximum amount of the trust fund that can be used for administrative expenses is \$1,500,000. 32 34 FISCAL NOTE REQUIRED 36 (See attached)

Fiscal Detail and Notes

This bill changes the amount of funds to be used for administrative expenses from 15% of the trust fund to \$407,000 in each fiscal year. The total amount for the duration of the program may not exceed \$1,500,000. Expenses for administrative costs reduce the amount available for claims for compensation.
