HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 265, L.D. 786, Bill, "An Act To Provide "Any-deer" Permits to Permanently Disabled Nonambulatory Persons"

Amend the amendment in section 1 in subsection 17 in the last line (page 1, line 34 in amendment) by inserting after the following: "subsection." the following: 'If the person who has such an ambulatory disability is the resident of a zone in which antlerless deer permits are not issued, that person may take an antlerless deer on the youth deer hunting day designated pursuant to section 7457, subsection 1, paragraph J.'

SUMMARY

This amendment allows a person who suffers an ambulatory disability and resides in a zone in which antlerless deer permits are not issued to take an antlerless deer on youth deer hunting day.
