COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 265, L.D. 786, Bill, "An Act To Provide "Any-deer" Permits to Permanently Disabled Nonambulatory Persons"

Amend the bill by striking out everything after the enacting clause and before the summary and inserting in its place the following:

'Sec. 1. 12 MRSA §7076, sub-§17 is enacted to read:

17. Transfer of antlerless deer permits to person with ambulatory disabilities. A person who holds a valid antlerless deer permit may transfer that permit to a person who is suffering from the loss of, or the permanent loss of the use of, both lower extremities. The commissioner shall administer transfers under this subsection.'

**SUMMARY**

This amendment replaces the bill and allows a person who holds a valid antlerless deer permit to transfer that permit to someone who suffers ambulatory disabilities.
