Sec. 1. 12 MRSA §7076, sub-§17 is enacted to read:

17. Nonambulatory disabilities. A person with a permanent disability causing the person to be unable to walk may be issued a complimentary antlerless deer permit under section 7457.

### SUMMARY

This bill provides that a person with a permanent disability causing the person to be unable to walk may receive a complimentary antlerless deer permit, otherwise known as an any-deer permit.
