	The liability of an organization consisting of volunteers
8	with the common purpose of supporting or advancing snowmobile
	activities is limited to \$100,000 for a claim arising out of a
10	single occurrence involving damages incurred as a result of the
	organization's activity of grooming trails.

16	This bill limits the liability of a snowmobile club to \$100,000 for damages resulting from an accident incident to the
