2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

4 **Sec. 1. 12 MRSA §7003** is enacted to read:

6 **§7003. Home possession of certain species**

8 For a species legally taken under chapter 707, 709 or 711
10 for which there is a limit to the number of animals of that
12 species a person may possess, the limitation does not include any
14 of that species that the person possesses in that person's home.

16 **SUMMARY**

This bill exempts from the possession limits in the hunting and fishing statutes of certain animals and fish any of those species that a person may possess in that person's home.
