Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
Sec.1. 12 MRSA §7003 is enacted to read:
§7003. Home possession of certain species
For a species legally taken under chapter 707, 709 or 711
for which there is a limit to the number of animals of that
species a person may possess, the limitation does not include any
of that species that the person possesses in that person's home.
SUMMARY
This bill exempts from the possession limits in the hunting
and fishing statutes of certain animals and fish any of those species that a person may possess in that person's home.
