Whereas,** Acts and resolves of the 2 Legislature do not become effective until 90 days after adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and

Whereas, this resolve concerns an event in April, which is before the 90-day period expires, and therefore needs to be enacted before adjournment; and

Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts create an emergency within the meaning of the Constitution of Maine and require the following legislation as immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety; now, therefore, be it

Sec. 1. Maine Aviation Education Week established. Resolved: 16 That the week beginning April 14, 2003 is Maine Aviation Education Week. The Department of Transportation, Office of 18 Passenger Transportation shall participate in the planning of events for this week under the auspices of the Maine Aeronautics 20 Association.

22 **Emergency clause.** In view of the emergency cited in the preamble, this resolve takes effect when approved.

SUMMARY

28 This resolve establishes the week beginning April 14, 2003 as Maine Aviation Education Week and directs the Department of 30 Transportation, Office of Passenger Transportation to participate in the planning of events for that week under the auspices of the 32 Maine Aeronautics Association.
