COMMITTEE AMENDMENT " " to S.P. 283, L.D. 804, Bill, "An Act To Amend the Standard Water District Enabling Act"

Amend the bill in section 1 by striking out all of paragraph A (page 1, lines 6 to 19 in L.D.) and inserting in its place the following:

'A. The following provisions apply to all water districts, regardless of when chartered, and any portion of a water district charter that is contrary to the provisions is void and of no effect:

(1) Section 6410, subsection 7; and

(2) Section 6410, subsection 8;

(3) Section 6413-A; and

(4) Section 6414-A.'

Further amend the bill by striking out all of section 2.

Further amend the bill in section 5 in that part designated "~~§6414-A.~~" in the 2nd paragraph in the form in the 15th line (page 4, line 19 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "sewer"

Further amend the bill by relettering or renumbering any nonconsecutive Part letter or section number to read consecutively.

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**SUMMARY**

This amendment, which is the majority report of the Joint Standing Committee on Utilities and Energy, removes that portion of the bill that proposed to grant water districts authority to regulate the volume and water quality of water within their territories. The amendment also makes a technical correction in the bill.
