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	This section applies only to public employees, as defined in
8	Title 26, section 962, subsection 6, except that department and
	division heads are deemed to be employees for the purposes of
10	this section.
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	SUMMARY
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	This bill includes department and division heads in the
16	definition of employee for the purposes of municipal employment
	residency requirements.
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
