2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

4 **Sec. 1. 17 MRSA §324, sub-§2,** as amended by PL 1997, c. 373,
§8, is further amended to read:

6 **2. Raffles.** Raffle tickets may be sold in accordance with
chapter 14. A "50/50" raffle may be conducted and the "beano"
8 equipment may be used in connection with this raffle.

10 **SUMMARY**

12 This bill provides that a "50/50" raffle may be conducted
14 during the period of one hour before the conduct of a "beano"
game and provides that the "beano" equipment may be used in
16 connection with the "50/50" raffle.
