'Sec. 1. Building of boat launch; access road. Resolved: That the Department of Conservation shall as expeditiously as possible apply for any permits necessary to build a boat launch on a parcel of land owned by the department on Branch Lake in Hancock County. The Department of Conservation, Bureau of Parks and Lands shall proceed with building the boat launch as soon as the permits are approved. Assuming permits are granted, the bureau shall cause the launch facility to be constructed and open for use no later than November 1, 2003.

The Department of Conservation, Bureau of Parks and Lands shall proceed with the design and planning for an access road to the boat launch from the Happy Town Road in Ellsworth. This amendment replaces the resolve and is the majority report of the Joint Standing Committee on Agriculture, Conservation and Forestry. It directs the Department of Conservation, Bureau of Parks and Lands to proceed with plans to construct a boat launch on Branch Lake in Ellsworth. It requires the boat launch to be constructed by November 1, 2003 and an access road from the Happy Town Road to be constructed and open to public traffic by October 1, 2004. The amendment also allocates necessary funds from the Boating Facilities Fund.

As amended, the bill includes an additional one-time Other Special Revenue funds allocation of \$400,000 in fiscal year 2003-04 for the Department of Conservation for the costs of developing a boat launch facility and access road in Ellsworth. According to the Department of Conservation, the authorization of this additional allocation for the Boating Facilities Fund will result in the deferral of 9 boating facilities projects currently scheduled for construction in fiscal year 2003-04.
