Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

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Sec. 1. 30-A MRSA §725, sub-§9, as amended by PL 1999, c. 253,
4 §8, is repealed.

Sec. 2. 30-A MRSA §924, first ¶, as amended by PL 2001, c. 349,
8 §6, is further amended to read:

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10 The county commissioners of each county shall use any
unencumbered surplus funds at the end of a fiscal year in the
12 following fiscal year only as provided in this section, ~~except~~
that ~~the Androscoggin County commissioners shall act in~~
14 ~~accordance with section 725, subsection 9.~~

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SUMMARY

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This bill removes the exception for Androscoggin County in
the law on use of county surplus funds.
