2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

12 Sec. 2. 29-A MRSA §1771 is enacted to read:

14 §1771. Motor Vehicle Inspection Advisory Board

16 1. Motor Vehicle Inspection Advisory Board. The Motor
17 Vehicle Inspection Advisory Board, established by Title 5,
18 section 12004-I, subsection 67-A and referred to in this section
19 as "the board," shall assist the Chief of the State Police to
20 perform the responsibilities required under this chapter. The
21 board consists of 8 voting members appointed by the Chief of the
22 State Police as follows:

24 A. One legislative member who is a member of the joint
25 standing committee of the Legislature having jurisdiction
26 over transportation matters;

28 B. One member representing the Maine State Police;

30 C. One member representing a statewide association of new
31 car dealers;

32 D. One member representing a statewide association of tow
33 truck operators;

35 E. One member representing official inspection stations;

37 F. One member representing fleet operators; and

39 G. Two members representing a statewide independent
40 automotive service association including:

42 (1) One member representing mechanical repair shops;
43 and

45 (2) One member representing collision repair shops.

47 2. Duties. The board shall assist and advise the Chief of
48 the State Police on matters involving the inspection of motor
49 vehicles in the State and other matters brought before the board
50 by the Chief of the State Police.
